



## Retail Job Positions

**Artist Booth (AB)** - Artist Booth Volunteers sell artist merchandise in the arts and crafts area for the period of time before and after the artist is on stage.

**Back Gate (BG)** - Back Gate Volunteers staff the back gate, selling wristbands to those entering the festival on Tuesday and Wednesday.

**CD Sales (CS)** - CD Sales Volunteers sell the recordings of the messages by the speakers at the Creation Festival. The cassette sales tent is located outside across from the Music Store in the Main Arena.

**Fringe Booth (FB)** - Fringe Booth Volunteers sell fringe stage artist merchandise in the tent near the Fringe stage for the period of time before and after the artist is on stage.

**Gates (GA)** - Gates Volunteers sell wristbands at the gates, and greet and register those coming into the main gate of the festival

**Grocery Store (GS)** - Grocery Store Volunteers work in the Festival Store located near the main arena, stocking shelves and running the cash registers.

**Ice Sales/Ice 2 (IC/I2)** - Ice Sales Volunteers sell ice to the festival attendees. The main booth is located near the food court, and the Ice 2 booth is located in the camping area.

**Music Store (MS)** - Music Store Volunteers work in the Music Store for the festival. The Music Store is located near the main arena.

**T-Shirts (T1/T2)** - T-shirts Volunteers sell Festival T-shirts in the main t-shirt booth (T1) located near the food court, and in the Arts & Crafts area (T2) at the top of the main arena.

## Camping Positions

**Gates Traffic (GT)** - Gates Traffic Volunteers help with the traffic flow coming into the festival. They meet at the entrance to the festival and make sure traffic is going in the correct directions and moving smoothly.

**Group Campsite Ushers (GU)** - Group Campsite Usher Volunteers guide the pre-registered groups of 20 or more to their pre-assigned campsites. They will ride bikes to escort the groups to their spots. Group Ushers meet at the "main crossroads" of the festival.

**Individual Campsite Ushers (IU)** - Individual Campsite Usher Volunteers help to guide Individuals, or groups that did not pre-register to campsites as they arrive on the grounds of the festival. Individual Ushers meet at the crossroads of the festival.

## Camping Positions Continued

**Traffic Control (TC)** - Traffic Control Volunteers help the festival attendees around the festival as they arrive. They also monitor traffic at various entrances to the grounds.

## Security Positions

**Arena Security (AS)** - Arena Security Volunteers help to keep the festival attendees in the main arena safe. They help with crowd control during main stage activities and securing the areas around the main stage, not including the backstage area.

**Fringe Safety (FS)** - Fringe Safety Volunteers help to keep the festival attendees in the Fringe Stage Area safe. They help with crowd control during Fringe stage activities and securing the areas around the Fringe stage, including the backstage area.

**Public Safety (PS)** - Public Safety Volunteers help to keep the festival attendees safe. They monitor activities around the grounds and help to deal with any problems that may occur.

**Stage Security (SS)** - Stage Security Volunteers help to keep the backstage area secure. They staff the gates leading into the backstage area and monitor entrance to the area for those with proper access.

## Technical Positions

**CD Recording (CR)** - Cassette Recording Volunteers assist in the taping of the messages by the speakers at the festival. They record the various afternoon seminars as well as the main stage speakers.

**Fringe Crew (FC)** - Fringe Crew Volunteers are the stage crew for the Fringe Stage. They assist in unloading band gear and setting it up for the band's performance.

**Golf Carts (GC)** - Golf Cart Volunteers assist in the maintenance and upkeep of the fleet of golf carts for the staff of the festival.

**Ham Radio (HR)** - Ham Radio Volunteers must be licensed operators, and they assist Public Safety and general traffic control to monitor the festival grounds.

**Medical (MD)** - Medical Volunteers help to deal with sicknesses, injuries and medical emergencies on the festival grounds.

**Plumbing (PL)** - Plumbing Volunteers help to maintain the water system at the festival, including any water problems in the buildings and bath houses.



## Technical Positions Cont'd

Stage Crew (SC) - Stage Crew Volunteers are the stage crew for the Main Stage. They assist in unloading band gear and setting it up for the band's performance. *\*This area is typically staffed with volunteers with prior experience at Creation Festivals or by recommendation.*

Transportation (TR) - Transportation Volunteers drive artists, speakers, and staff to and from where they need to go. *\*This area is typically staffed with volunteers with prior experience at Creation Festivals and by recommendation only.*

Technical Services (TS) - Technical Service Volunteers maintain the festival, from construction to electrical wiring, to repair and maintenance. *\*This area is typically staffed with volunteers with prior experience at Creation Festivals or by recommendation.*

## Miscellaneous Positions

Children's Ministry (CM) - Children's Ministry Volunteers help out in the Children's tent during the programs there. They sell artist merchandise and help out in other areas with the children. *\*This area is typically staffed with volunteers with prior experience at Creation Festivals or by recommendation.*

Clean-up (CU) - Clean-up Volunteers help to keep the bathrooms and bathhouses clean and well stocked.

Deaf Interpretation (DI) - Deaf Interpretation Volunteers must be skilled in sign language, and assist our hearing-impaired attendees by signing the activities on the main stage including the music and the speakers.

Finance (FI) - Finance Volunteers help with the financial side of festival activities. *\*This area is typically staffed with volunteers with prior experience at Creation Festivals or by recommendation.*

Flex Crew (FX) - Flex Crew is a crew that meets at the staff office each shift and is assigned to whatever area is in need of extra help that shift. So, wherever you are needed, you are sent. This is a fun way to see how different areas work around the festival.

Lost and Found (LF) - Lost and Found Volunteers work in conjunction with Public Safety to keep track of lost items and take care of lost children while they wait to be reunited with their group.

Music Contest (MC) - Music Contest Volunteers help attendees register for the various giveaways at the festival. They generally work out of the main T-shirt booth.

## Miscellaneous Positions Continued

Office (OF) - Office Volunteers help attendees with questions at the Main Festival Office. They help them register their campsites, and other questions.

Prayer Tent (PT) - Prayer Tent Volunteers pray with festival attendees seeking prayer. This is not a counseling position. It is prayer support. **You must be recommended by our prayer team supervisors in order to serve in this position.**

Press (PR) - Press Volunteers help members of the media register with the Creation Media Tent. They help stock snacks and drinks for press conferences with the artists and members of the press. **You must be recommended by our press supervisor in order to serve in this position.**

Set-up (S1-S13) - Set-up Volunteers help get the festival grounds ready for the festival to begin. Crews include Steel Crew to set-up the stage, Technical Crew to get all the "technical" things ready, various crews to clean the bath houses and restrooms and many other pre-festival tasks.

Staff Office (ST) - Staff Office Volunteers help check in staff volunteers and answer questions for staff members.

Tear-Down (TD1/TD2/TD3) - Tear-Down Volunteers help tear-down and clean-up after the festival is over. Many people are still needed for this job, and all are welcome to help. This job involves tearing down the stage, collecting trash, gathering tables and tents, and many other duties.
